**Whereas**, Oklahoma licensed professional engineers have made significant contributions to our state and our economy; and

**Whereas**, engineers are professionals concerned with applying scientific knowledge, mathematics and ingenuity to develop answers for technical, societal, and commercial problems; and

**Whereas**, Oklahoma's workforce coordination is committed to the development and training of students in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) programs and degrees; and

**Whereas**, in a 21<sup>st</sup> century economy, engineers are faced with many challenges in developing sustainable structures and systems; and

**Whereas**, August 3, 2016, has been affirmed Professional Engineer's Day by the Oklahoma Society of Professional Engineers in conjunction with the National Society of Professional Engineers, an organization of 31,000 that represents the interests of licensed professional engineers in all 50 states and U.S. territories;

**Now, Therefore, I, Mary Fallin, Governor**, do hereby proclaim August 3, 2016, as
