The Oklahoma Society of Professional Engineers is now accepting workshop/session proposals for the 2026 Annual Conference to be held in Oklahoma City, OK.

The Annual Oklahoma Engineering Conference consists of training sessions and general interest sessions for members and non-members of OSPE, a state society of the National Society of Professional Engineers. The Conference attendees will include professional engineers from all cities and counties in Oklahoma as well as engineers with diverse background and work environments, including industry, government, education, construction, and private practice.

The purpose of the sessions is to provide continuing education courses that will allow OSPE members to meet continuing professional competence requirements for PE license renewal, as required by the Oklahoma State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Surveyors. These sessions should focus on topics of interest to engineers from all engineering disciplines and work environments. Each session should be approximately 50-60 minutes in length and **should not be a “commercial” for your company.**
